- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Emergency Medical Services Practice
- 2 Act; to amend section 38-1216, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 3 Supplement, 2024; to change requirements for the Board of Emergency
- 4 Medical Services; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 38-1216, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 38-1216 In addition to any other responsibilities prescribed by the
- 4 Emergency Medical Services Practice Act, the board shall:
- 5 (1) Promote the dissemination of public information and education
- 6 programs to inform the public about emergency medical service and other
- 7 medical information, including appropriate methods of medical self-help,
- 8 first aid, and the availability of emergency medical services training
- 9 programs in the state;
- 10 (2) Provide for the collection of information for evaluation of the
- 11 availability and quality of emergency medical care, evaluate the
- 12 availability and quality of emergency medical care, and serve as a focal
- 13 point for discussion of the provision of emergency medical care;
- 14 (3) Establish model procedures for patient management in medical
- 15 emergencies that do not limit the authority of law enforcement and fire
- 16 protection personnel to manage the scene during a medical emergency;
- 17 (4) Undertake Not less than once each five years, undertake a review
- 18 and evaluation of the act and its implementation together with a review
- 19 of the emergency medical care needs of the residents of the State of
- 20 Nebraska and submit <u>an annual report</u> electronically a report to the
- 21 Legislature. The report shall include aggregate data on the following:
- 22 (a) Number of emergency medical services telephone calls in Nebraska; (b)
- 23 number of emergency medical services calls listed by emergency medical
- 24 services organizational status; (c) total number of emergency medical
- 25 services calls listed by emergency medical services primary patient
- 26 caregiver level of care; (d) the average response times for each region;
- 27 <u>(e) the age range of patients; (f) the nature of each patient complaint;</u>
- 28 (g) provider impression for each patient; (h) disposition of each
- 29 <u>patient; (i) number of active emergency medical services providers</u>
- 30 licensed in Nebraska; and (j) data with comparisons to other national
- 31 regions or states with any recommendations which it may have; and

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- 1 (5) Identify communication needs of emergency medical services and
- 2 make recommendations for development of a communications plan for a
- 3 communications network for emergency care providers and emergency medical
- 4 services.
