1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section
2 60-6,179.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change and
3 eliminate provisions relating to the use of handheld wireless
4 communication devices while operating a motor vehicle; and to repeal
5 the original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. Section 60-6,179.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2	Nebraska, is amended to read:
3	60-6,179.01 (1) This section does not apply to an operator of a
4	commercial motor vehicle if section 60-6,179.02 applies.
5	(2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3) of this section,
6	no person shall physically hold or support with any part of his or her
7	body, or otherwise use, a handheld wireless communication device while
8	operating a motor vehicle that is in motion. to read a written
9	communication, manually type a written communication, or send a written
10	communication while operating a motor vehicle which is in motion.
11	<u>(3)(a)</u> The prohibition in subsection (2) of this section does
12	not apply to:
13	<u>(i)</u> (a) A person performing his or her official duties as a law
14	enforcement officer, a firefighter, an ambulance driver, or an emergency
15	medical technician; or
16	<u>(ii) Any employee or contractor of a utility service provider who is</u>
17	responding to a utility emergency; or
18	<u>(iii)</u> (b) A person operating a motor vehicle in an emergency
19	situation, but only if such person is communicating or attempting to
20	communicate with emergency services.
21	(b) The prohibition in subdivisions (2)(a), (b), and (c) of this
22	section does not apply to any person who is operating a motor vehicle
23	that is in motion if such person is using the handheld wireless
24	communication device:
25	(i) Without touching such handheld wireless communication device; or
26	(ii) To initiate a function of such handheld wireless communication
27	device with a single touch.
28	(4) Enforcement of this section by state or local law enforcement
29	agencies shall be accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver
30	of a motor vehicle has been cited or charged with a traffic violation or

31 some other offense.

1 <u>(4)</u> (5) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a 2 traffic infraction. Any person who is found guilty of a traffic 3 infraction under this section shall be assessed points on his or her 4 motor vehicle operator's license pursuant to section 60-4,182 and shall 5 be fined:

6 (a) Two hundred dollars for the first offense;

(b) Three hundred dollars for a second offense; and

8 (c) Five hundred dollars for a third and subsequent offense.

9 (5) (6) For purposes of this section:

10 (a) Commercial motor vehicle has the same meaning as in section11 75-362;

(b)(i) Handheld wireless communication device means any device that
provides for written communication between two or more parties and is
capable of receiving, displaying, or transmitting written communication.

(ii) Handheld wireless communication device includes, but is not
limited to, a mobile or cellular telephone, a text messaging device, a
personal digital assistant, a pager, or a laptop computer.

(iii) Handheld wireless communication device does not include an
electronic device that is part of the motor vehicle or permanently
attached to the motor vehicle or a handsfree wireless communication
device; and

(c) Written communication includes, but is not limited to, a text
message, an instant message, electronic mail, and Internet websites.
