- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- Section 1. Section 47-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 47-502 Any person sentenced to or confined in a city or county jail,
- 4 including any person serving a custodial sanction imposed in response to
- 5 a parole or probation violation, shall, after the fifteenth day of his or
- 6 her confinement, have the aggregate of his or her remaining term,
- 7 <u>including the sum of all consecutive sentences the person receives,</u>
- 8 whether received at the same time or at any time during such sentence or
- 9 confinement, reduced one day for each day of his or her sentence or
- 10 sanction during which he or she has not committed any breach of
- 11 discipline or other violation of jail regulations.
- 12 Sec. 2. Original section 47-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, is repealed.
