Section 1. Section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024, is amended to read:

3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 <u>and section 2 of this act</u>
4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability
5 and Disclosure Act.

No person shall make one or more contributions to a 6 Sec. 2. 7 candidate committee totaling more than one thousand dollars during an election period. A candidate committee shall, within ten days after 8 9 receipt, refund any contribution from a person which exceeds a total of 10 one thousand dollars received during an election period from such person 11 and report such contribution on subsequent campaign statements disclosing the name and address of the contributor, the amount received, the date of 12 receipt, and the date returned. This section does not apply to a 13 candidate's own personal funds contributed to that candidate's committee. 14 For purposes of this section, election period means the calendar year of 15 16 the election. 17 Sec. 3.
