1	Section 1. (1) Notwithstanding section 44-3,131, (a) any individual
2	or group sickness and accident insurance policy or subscriber contract
3	delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this state and any
4	hospital, medical, or surgical expense-incurred policy, except for
5	policies that provide coverage for a specified disease or other limited-
6	benefit coverage, and (b) any self-funded employee benefit plan to the
7	<u>extent not preempted by federal law shall include coverage for pre-</u>
8	exposure prophylaxis medication for the prevention of human
9	immunodeficiency virus infection if prescribed by a physician or health
10	care professional legally authorized by law to prescribe such medication.
11	<u>(2) This section does not prevent application of deductible or</u>
12	copayment provisions or network incentives contained in the policy,
13	<u>contract, or plan.</u>
