Section 1. (1) On motion of a defendant in a civil action involving

- 2 <u>a commercial motor vehicle requiring a commercial driver's license, the</u>
- 3 trial court shall dismiss from the civil action any claim of the
- 4 defendant's direct negligence if the defendant stipulates that at the
- 5 time of the event that caused the damages that are the subject of the
- 6 <u>civil action all of the following are true:</u>
- 7 (a) The person whose negligence is alleged to have caused the
- 8 <u>damages was the defendant's employee or independent contractor; and</u>
- 9 <u>(b) The person whose negligence is alleged to have caused the</u>
- 10 damages was acting within the course and scope of employment with the
- 11 <u>defendant or acting as an independent contractor of the defendant.</u>
- 12 (2) If a defendant makes the stipulations described in subsection
- 13 (1) of this section with respect to an employee or independent contractor
- 14 and the employee's or independent contractor's negligence is found to
- 15 have caused or contributed to causing the damages, the defendant's
- 16 liability in the civil action shall be adjudged solely on the basis of
- 17 the legal doctrine known as respondeat superior.
- 18 (3) For purposes of this section, commercial motor vehicle has the
- 19 same meaning as in section 60-316.
