Section 1. Section 71-8616, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 71-8616 (1) The commission shall develop a statewide support service
- 4 provider program for deaf-blind persons that facilitates a transition
- 5 from dependency to independent living and participation in society. All
- 6 property, equipment, supplies, and personnel which belonged to, were
- 7 allocated to, or were used to support the Division of Rehabilitation
- 8 Services for the Visually Impaired within the Department of Health and
- 9 Human Services prior to July 1, 2000, are transferred to the Commission
- 10 for the Blind and Visually Impaired.
- 11 (2) The program shall include, but not be limited to, (a) assistance
- 12 to live independently, (b) access to visual, situational, and
- 13 <u>environmental information</u>, (c) <u>services of a human guide</u>, (d)
- 14 <u>facilitation</u> of <u>brief</u>, <u>casual exchanges</u> of <u>spoken</u> or <u>signed</u>
- 15 conversations, and (e) assistance with daily living activities such as
- 16 <u>transportation to and from appointments, reading and sorting mail, and</u>
- 17 recipes and food labeling.
- 18 (3) The commission may contract with a private provider or may offer
- 19 <u>the services directly through the program.</u>
- 20 (4) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate one hundred
- 21 thousand dollars from the General Fund for fiscal year 2025-26 and one
- 22 hundred thousand dollars from the General Fund for fiscal year 2026-27 to
- 23 the commission for the statewide support service provider program.
- 24 (2) All existing contracts and agreements in effect on July 1, 2000,
- 25 as to the Division of Rehabilitation Services for the Visually Impaired
- 26 within the Department of Health and Human Services are binding and
- 27 effective upon the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired.
- 28 Sec. 2. Original section 71-8616, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 29 Nebraska, is repealed.
- 30 **Sec. 3.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 31 passed and approved according to law.
