## Committee:

- 1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST
- 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 **Section 1.** At the general election in November 2026, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To amend Article III, section 22:
- 7 **III-22** (1) Each Legislature shall make appropriations for the
- 8 expenses of the Government. And whenever it is deemed necessary to make
- 9 further appropriations for deficiencies, the same shall require a two-
- 10 thirds vote of all the members elected to the Legislature.
- 11 (2) Bills making appropriations for the pay of members and officers
- 12 of the Legislature, and for the salaries of the officers of the
- 13 Government, shall contain no provision on any other subject.
- 14 (3) The Legislature shall not impose responsibility for a program
- 15 <u>created after the year 2026 or an increased level of service</u> required
- 16 <u>under an existing program after the year 2026 on any political</u>
- 17 subdivision of the state unless the political subdivision is fully
- 18 reimbursed by the state for the cost of such program or increase in level
- 19 of service. Reimbursement by the state shall be in the form of a specific
- 20 appropriation or an increase in state distribution of revenue to such
- 21 political subdivision.
- 22 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 23 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,

- 1 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 2 A constitutional amendment to require the state to reimburse
- 3 political subdivisions for responsibilities imposed by the Legislature
- 4 after the year 2026 or for increased levels of service required by the
- 5 Legislature after the year 2026.
