LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 250

Introduced by Andersen, 49; Cavanaugh, J., 9; Hunt, 8; Lonowski, 33; McKeon, 41; Wordekemper, 15.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to propose an interim study to examine whether power companies should be exempt from the Secure Drone Purchasing Act. The study should also include an examination as to whether requirements of the North American Electric Reliability Corporation are sufficient to meet the intent of the Secure Drone Purchasing Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

- 1. That the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
- 2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
