LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 457

Introduced by Hallstrom, 1.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to propose an interim study to identify the barriers to multiple employer insurance plans. Multiple employer insurance plans allow employers to pool their risks and jointly purchase health insurance for employees. This model supports smaller employers by reducing administrative costs, allowing access to better insurance rates, and offering large group benefits. The study shall include, but not be limited to, a review of state and federal statutes and rules and regulations applicable to multiple employer insurance plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
