LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 8

WHEREAS, Aric Hall of Coleridge, Nebraska, a member of Coleridge Boy Scout
Troop 208, has completed the requirements for the rank of Eagle Scout in the
Boy Scouts of America; and

WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in scouting, a Boy Scout must fulfill requirements in the areas of leadership, service, and outdoor skills. WHEREAS, to achieve the rank of Eagle Scout, a Boy Scout is required to earn twenty-one merit badges, fourteen of which are in required areas, and complete an approved community service project; and

WHEREAS, for his community service project, Aric planned and organized a refurbishing of Coleridge's War Memorial; and

WHEREAS, Aric, through his hard work and perseverance, has joined other high achievers who are Eagle Scouts, including astronauts, leaders of government and industry, artists, scientists, and athletes.
