Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB1223

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The intent of LB 1223 is to place reasonable limits on the brightness of motor vehicle headlights, which have become brighter and more potentially hazardous as manufacturing technologies have evolved. Exceedingly bright headlights can pose serious risks by temporarily impairing the vision of nearby motorists.

LB 1223 addresses two components of this problem. First, it establishes parameters for the properties of headlights themselves. Second, it requires that exceedingly bright headlights must be dimmed or adjusted when passing or within close range of another vehicle.
