## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

**LB1225**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

As currently written, Nebraska Revised Statute § 43-274 governs orders granting or denying the transfer of juvenile cases from juvenile court to county or district court under section 5 (b), and provides that any appeal of such an order shall be expedited, with the Court of Appeals rendering its judgment or opinion “as speedily as possible.” If enacted, LB 1225 would amend § 43-274(5)(b) to require that the Court of Appeals render its judgment or opinion within ninety days after the date the appeal is perfected. This change is intended to promote the timely resolution of jurisdictional disputes in juvenile proceedings by providing a clear and uniform deadline for appellate review of transfer orders.
