Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The intent of the Developmental Disabilities Provider Excessive Training and Cost Reduction Act is to prohibit the Department of Health and Human Services from imposing unnecessarily costly training requirements on employees of providers and to ensure that training requirements imposed by the department are focused solely on ensuring the health, safety, and welfare of the individuals served by providers. The Developmental Disabilities Provider Excessive Training and Cost Reduction Act is further meant to ensure that such training requirements are appropriate, competitively priced, and meet all federal requirements for the provision of developmental disabilities services.
