The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Upon passage of LB 51, Nebraska would join the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact.

Currently, NSP is required to submit every fingerprint-based arrest to the FBI to ensure FBI records match Nebraska's records. After joining the compact, Nebraska would become the sole maintainer and provider of our criminal history records, thus eliminating the need to submit subsequent arrest events, expungement notices, and disposition information to the FBI.
