## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB754**

The intent of LB754 is to extend the maximum validity period for explosive use permits from two years to three years, matching the federal permit schedule. This change will reduce administrative burden and renewal costs for permit holders while maintaining safety standards. The bill also clarifies that applicants for a State Fire Marshal display permit must provide proof of a valid Nebraska State Patrol explosive use permit.
