The intent of LB755 is to establish confidential peer support programs for emergency service employees who experience stress and trauma from their work. The bill creates legal protections ensuring that communications during peer support sessions remain privileged and confidential, encouraging employees to seek help without fear that their statements could be used against them in disciplinary or legal proceedings. By fostering a supportive framework for mental health assistance, LB755 aims to reduce long-term negative impacts on emergency service personnel and promote workforce resilience.
