## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB830**

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**Chairperson: Senator Rita Sanders**

**Committee: Government, Military and Veterans Affairs**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB830 provides for three key changes: 1) Eliminates monthly payroll requirements of certain state officers or employees; 2) Expands eligibility of buildings for funding under the Deferred Building Renewal Act; and 3) Eliminates an obsolete reporting requirement of the Department of Administrative Services.

LB830 amends all statutes that currently require state salaries to be paid monthly. The monthly references are changed to compensation in equal payroll installments, which streamlines the payroll processing for state employees.

LB830 allows buildings on federally licensed land maintained by the Nebraska Military Department to be eligible for Building Renewal Allocation Funds. There are currently seven such buildings across the state.

Lastly, LB830 repeals Nebraska Revised Statute § 83-380. This requirement of the Department of Administrative Services to notify counties of amounts owed is unnecessary and duplicative to the monthly billing of counties by the Department of Health and Human Services for state institutional/hospital costs.
