

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 1188

Approved by the Governor March 6, 1972

Introduced by Orval A. Keyes, 3rd District

AN ACT relating to metropolitan utilities districts; to provide for the collection of sewer use or rental fees or charges for other utility services for cities, villages, and sanitary and improvement districts, residents of which are supplied water at retail by such districts; and to restrict discontinuance of services as prescribed.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. If a metropolitan utilities district shall supply water at retail to residents of a city or village other than a metropolitan city, or of a sanitary and improvement district, whether or not such city, village or sanitary and improvement district is within the district boundaries, such city, village or sanitary and improvement district and metropolitan utilities district shall have power and authority to enter into a contract to obtain the use of facilities and services of the water utility of such district in order to collect from the residents supplied water by the district sewer use or rental fees or charges for other utility services for such city, village or sanitary and improvement district, in the same manner and to the same extent as is provided for such services to metropolitan cities, by sections 14-1108 to 14-1110, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943. No utility service under this section shall be discontinued for nonpayment of charges for unrelated services.
