## LEGISLATIVE BILL 254

Approved by the Governor March 11, 1971

AN ACT to amend section 79-1705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to schools; to provide for additional personnel to inspect private, denominational, and parochial schools as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-1705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-1705. The county superintendent in first class school districts, or the superintendent of schools in all other districts, where any private, denominational, or parochial school is located, shall inspect such schools and report to the proper officers any evidence of the use of any textbooks or of any activities, instruction, or propaganda therein subversive to American institutions and republican form of government or good citizenship or of failure to observe any of the provisions of sections 79-1701 to 79-1707; Provided, that the Commissioner of Education. when in his judgment it is deemed advisable, may appoint a public school official other than the above, including a member of the State Department of Education, for such inspections. Such appointee shall hold either a Nebraska Administrative and Supervisory Certificate, or a Nebraska Professional Administrative and Supervisory Certificate. The State Board of Education shall require the several county superintendents and superintendents of schools and appointed public school officials to make such inspections at least twice a year, and the school officers of such schools and the teachers giving permit instruction therein are required to inspection and assist and cooperate in the making of the same.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-1705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
