

LEGISLATIVE BILL 328

Approved by the Governor March 23, 1971

Introduced by Jerome Warner, 25th District

AN ACT to amend section 86-336, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to telecommunications; to provide for the cost of moving lines; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 86-336, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

86-336. Any owner of any telephone, electric transmission, or electric distribution line failing to move its lines, poles or anchors located on a public highway in accordance with the notice provided by section 86-334 shall be liable to the county or township for the cost of relocating such lines, or any of its poles and anchors. When an owner of such facilities located on private right-of-way is required to move the same, it shall be at the expense of the county or township. The county or township shall be liable to the owner of any telephone, electric transmission, or electric distribution line for loss of use of such line for failure to give the notice required by the provisions of sections 86-334 and 86-335.

Sec. 2. That original section 86-336, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
