

LEGISLATIVE BILL 492

AN ACT to amend section 84-1307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the State Employees Retirement System; to restrict membership in the system as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 84-1307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

84-1307. The membership of the retirement system shall be composed of all permanent full-time employees who have been employees for a period of twenty-four continuous months at any time and who have attained the age of thirty. ~~Provided, that membership~~ Membership shall not include part-time or temporary employees, except (1) such part-time employees who have been full-time employees but because of age or otherwise have been partially incapacitated and have been placed on a part-time service basis at a part-time rate of pay under rules and regulations of the retirement board, and (2) such part-time employees who are members of the system.

Sec. 2. That original section 84-1307, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
