SENATOR GOODRICH: I don't have the contract data.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Was it with Bozell and Jacobs?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well, it would be for several different places like TV, the radio, newspapers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But I meant who got the agreement for providing the advertising copy, the material?

SENATOR GOODRICH: You are saying, who is the advertising agent in charge. I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Was it Bozell and Jacobs?

SENATOR GOODRICH: I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: How much interest was paid to the promoters for the money they invested?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Interest on...this is revenue. From the other day, you indicated 12% and we got some figures back here that indicated that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, while you are looking at that...

SENATOR GOODRICH: You said the other day, 12%. I don't doubt that. I don't question that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, how much, again, now did you say was available for prizes? \$900,000, is that right?

SENATOR GOODRICH: No, that is what had been paid in prize expense.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, \$900,000 has been paid.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Right. \$442,543 is now the balance... there is actually a cash balance right now, since they have closed their books, the net balance on hand is \$266,028 which will be distributed, either in prize money or to pay off any small stuff that they have got in the way of bills coming in.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, these people came down here at the last minute and gave Senator Goodrich and Senator Mahoney these figures and I can understand him not finding exactly on an instance notice where these figures are that I was asking him about because they hadn't gotten the figures to him. They didn't know that they were going to have to have staunch defenders on the floor defending, remember not these small lotteries that Senator Mahoney in his testimony said was the purpose of the lotteries. It was Senator Mahoney's words that were used in the court to defeat Big Green and it was Senator Mahoney's words that led the Judge to say, one shot operation lotteries, the little mother and father lottery, the church, the charitable organization, and now Senator Mahoney stands up here and impeaches his own words.
