## LEGISLATIVE BILL 673

Approved by the Governor March 3, 1978

Introduced by Barnett, 26

AN ACT to amend section 39-669.13, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to rules of the road; to provide for the payment of certain fees by any person convicted of driving while under the influence of alcoholic liquor or of any drug; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-669.13, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

39-669.13. Upon the conviction of any person for violation of the provisions of section 39-669.07, or of driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic liquor or of any drug in violation of any city or village ordinance, there shall be assessed as part of the court costs the fee charged by any physician or any agency administering tests pursuant to a permit issued in accordance with section 39-669.11, for the test administered and the analysis thereof under the provisions of section 39-669.08, if such test was actually made.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-669.13, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
