AN ACT to amend section 46-651, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, 1943, relating to irrigation: to
limit the spacing of wells as prescribed; and
to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 46-651, Reissue Revised
Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as
follows:

46-651. Except as provided in section 46-653 or
or 46-654, (1) after November 18, 1965, no irrigation or
industrial well or well of any other city or village
shall be drilled within one thousand feet of any well of
any city or village used to supply such city or village
and its inhabitants with water, and no well of any such
city or village shall be drilled within one thousand feet
of any such irrigation or industrial well, and (2) after
the effective date of this act no irrigation well shall
be drilled within one thousand feet of an industrial well
and no industrial well shall be drilled within one
thousand feet of an irrigation or industrial well. Such
prohibitions shall not apply to wells owned by the same
person.

Sec. 2. That original section 46-651, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
