SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I nominate Senator Moylan.

PRESIDENT: Senator Moylan is nominated. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, I would like to nominate Shirley Marsh.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh is nominated. Our rules require five members. Senator Clark of Sidney.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I nominate Senator Duis.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis has been nominated. Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I nominate Senator Fowler.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fowler has been nominated. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. President, I would nominate Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly has been nominated. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move the nominations close.

PRESIDENT: You have heard that motion. Record your vote on that motion. Make the record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to close nominations, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Nominations are closed. We have five nominees. Would you read them, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Moylan, Senator Marsh, Senator Duis, Senator Fowler and Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Those have been nominated. Record your vote on the election of those members to the Committee on Credentials. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays on the election of the five committee members, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, those members have been elected. Will the committee just elected please retire to the rear of the chamber to meet with The Honorable Allen Beermann, Secretary of State who has a report for you. Is the committee ready to bring the report to the Clerk's desk? Senator Moylan, do I understand correctly that you are the Chairperson of this committee? Would you kindly make the report, Madam Chairman.
