SENATOR MOYLAN: I will. The Credentials Committee makes this report. Returns, abstracts of election are in order and have been duly canvassed. The elect are certified and I hand you herewith the documents.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The Chair recognizes Senator Maurice Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I move the report of the Committee on Credentials be accepted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Is there any discussion? Record your vote. Make the record.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to accept the report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The report has been accepted. The Chair directs the Sergeant At Arms to proceed to the chambers of the Supreme Court to escort The Honorable Norman Krivosha, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to the chamber. Oh, all right. I guess we are going to have an escort committee. Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. Chairman, I move that a committee of five members be appointed to escort the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to the legislative chamber for the purpose of administering the oath of office to the newly elected members of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Record your vote. Make the record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Clark's motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted. The Chair appoints Senator Kennedy, Senator Rumery, Senator Clark, Senator Marvel and Senator Frank Lewis to escort the Chief Justice into the chamber. We will be at ease until the arrival of the Chief Justice.

PRESIDENT: We have some delay because the Supreme Court is actually sitting today so they will have to go into recess so that the Chief Justice can come here.

The Legislature will please come to order. The Chair recognizes the Sergeant At Arms. Clear the center aisle please.
