PRESIDENT: And now I present to you the Chief Justice of the State of Nebraska on his little box, The Honorable Norman Krivosha. You may be seated.

Kremer, Ron Cope, John DeCamp, Myron G. Rumery and William E. Nichol and Senators elect Peter Hoagland, Vard Johnson, Carol McBride Pirsch, Harold F. Sieck, Don Wesely, Chris Beutler, Tom Vickers, Rex S. Haberman and David M. Landis. Are you all here? Will you all please raise your right hand. (Administered oath of office.) Now will you one by one please come forward and affix your signature to the document on the table?

PRESIDENT: Before we ask the committee to escort the Chief Justice from the chamber, could we have order please, I would ask that everyone rise for a moment's silence in memory of Harold Moylan, one of the most effective and delightful people ever to walk into this chamber. Would you all rise please for a moment of silence?

CHIEF JUSTICE KRIVOSHA: Thank you, Mr. President.
