CLERK: Madam President, Legislative Resolution 4 offered by Senator Patrick Venditte, Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Carole Pirsch and Senator David Newell. (Read LR 4.) Mr. President, that resolution may be found on Page 175 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. I call on Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I think just to simply reiterate some of what the Clerk has read into the record this morning, I have been a part of the Omaha Softball Association for approximately 12 years, and it no doubt is probably one of Douglas County, Sarpy County, and part of Iowa's Pottawattamie County's favorite pastime, at least during the early...the late spring, summer and early fall. I know in looking into the past...the past record of the Omaha Softball Association, it's rather obvious that there are probably more people involved in softball than any other recreational program in the city of Omaha, and I think it's kind of interesting that the state of Nebraska has been singled out as the nation's number 1 capital in softball...matter of fact it's in the world.
