LB 76

LB 76 to Select File for specific amendment. (Read Dworak amendment found on page 302 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, this amendment is in a technical nature. When we struck a section in the original bill we got a call from the Department of Administrative Services that said by striking that section some of the definitions are unclear and conceivably we could be making a change into those who would receive homestead exemption. Now that was not the intent of this. If you will recall, this bill is only to change the reporting date. We had no intent at all to change definitions or eligibility or qualifications. This is a clarifying amendment that was brought up by the bill drafter, Bruce Cutshall. The Department of Revenue is now satisfied, the Department of Administrative Services is satisfied, the accounting officials are satisfied, it is corrective in nature and I urge the return of this to Select File to put on this amendment.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Any discussion then on the motion to return to Select File for the specific amendment? If not, all those in favor of returning LB 76 for the purpose of the specific amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The motion carries and the bill is returned. The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right. The motion is to adopt the specific amendment. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of adopting the amendment to LB 76 vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Dworak's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The Dworak amendment is adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak for purpose of readvancement.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.
