PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion to readvance LB 76 to E & R final. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 76 is readvanced to E & R final. Announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy asks unanimous consent to print an amendment to LB 124 in the Legislative Journal. (See page 302.)

Mr. President, Senator Newell asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 9 to March 16, 1979.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Is there any objection? Senator Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Which bill are we talking about?

CLERK: LB 9, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Until when?

CLERK: March 16th.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I object. If we start bracketing bills, we are dead so I object.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: There is an objection, Senator Newell. Do you wish to...?

SPEAKER MARVEL: We can discuss it tomorrow if you like but if we are going to stall on legislation we just as well indicate that there will be three or four hundred bills that we won't even reach. Now I will be very glad to talk to Senator Newell later but if we are going to begin to bracket bills like this, we just as well throw in the towel and go home so I object.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Senator Newell, do you wish to take it up tomorrow? All right. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: All right, the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that we adjourn until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.
