LB 47, 124A

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, I so move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing the bill to E & R for Review vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Senator Koch, are you ready for LB 124A? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 124A. Read title.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, a week ago we discussed LB 124. To refresh your thinking, it had to do with the Talking Book Radio Programs and the fiscal impact of that program to expand it is approximately \$30,000 and that is what this bill calls for. I ask for the advancement of LB 124A to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion? Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, I have a question, perhaps of the Chair. LB 124 is on Select File and has an amendment that is pending. It may be that unless that amendment is adopted, for some members of this body they cannot be supportive of the advancement of LB 124A. So the question I am asking is whether or not we could take up the amendment to LB 124 prior to acting on LB 124A?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair would suggest this procedure, that we vote on LB 124 and let it proceed. If there is any problem with, I am sorry, LB 124A, if there is any problem with LB 124 on Select File there is no damage done. We have at least taken advantage of the time and moved the bill across.

SENATOR KOCH: I have an amendment up there, Senator Stoney, and I will strike that provision that says "shall not be limited to" and I am willing to do that. If you bracket LB 124 on Select File to a date specific, it doesn't bother me but I would like to have LB 124A catch up with it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 124A to E & R for Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.
