PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I agree with Senator Cullan that we should adopt the amendment but I also agree with Senator Murphy that once we have adopted these amendments then I would urge you to look carefully and long at the bill, because if anyone tries to tell me that the Nebraska Legislature is not adopting a position in regard to water or land use management, if you take a look at LB 26, there are provisions in that bill that are very extensive and very far-reaching. Again I concur with Senator Cullan. The amendments need to be adopted and then, hopefully, we can proceed with the discussion of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Kremer. All right. The Chair recognizes Senator Kelly. Where is Senator Kelly? The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I will call for the question.

PRESIDENT: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. The question then before the House is shall debate cease. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? The question before the House is shall debate cease on the committee amendments proposed on LB 26. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. We will continue to debate the issue. The next person I have on the list is Senator Kahle. Would those of you when you decide to talk, put on a light, turn it off when you don't decide to talk anymore. Senator Cullan, you wished to speak on the bill itself, didn't you? You didn't wish to speak to the amendments any more. All right. Senator Kahle. Speaking to the committee amendments, Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: To the amendments.

PRESIDENT: To the committee amendments, yes. We are still on the committee amendments.

SENATOR KAHLE: All I want to do is support the amendments. Thank you.
