SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...this instance the principle of double effect serves the function of nullifying all principles. I have my motion there and I hope you will vote favorably, but I do have another one, Senator George.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, your light is on. For what purpose do you...Senator Chambers has closed on his motion. Okay the vote...the motion is to return LB 117 to Select File for specific amendment, and the amendment is to strike the enacting clause. Is that right? All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Is there another motion on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk will read.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves to suspend Rule 6, Sections 7(a,b,c,d) as well as to vote on LB 117 without further debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, Mr. President, we're in a tactical standoff here. Senator Chambers has additional motions... one motion, just one? That's all you're going to do? Okay, you can pull mine.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you asking unanimous consent, Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you asking unanimous consent to withdraw your motion?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any objection? Since I hear no objection...do you object? Do you want to move, Senator DeCamp, that your motion be withdrawn?

SENATOR DeCAMP: What's the motion following it?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion at the moment...
