I says, fine if it'll make everybody happy and nobody will hate me, I'll let you delay it as long as you want, as long as it's somewhat reasonable. Senator Marvel says, well, Don will get back, and we'll take it up Monday. Bernice wants to delay till Monday. Fine, I'm ready to go today. Okay, so, I ask unanimous consent again to withdraw the motion, let him have his amendments, fine by me.
