CLERK: 14 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Record your presence. Those who have no business on the floor, please leave the floor. How many are excused, still two? Senator Kremer. All unauthorized personnel will have to leave the Chamber, leave the floor. Yes, the Clerk will accept votes.

CLERK: Senator Wesely voting aye. Senator Merz voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting on the Johnson amendment to the second Venditte amendment found on page 620. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, let me read to you those who are not here, Senator Kennedy, Senator Keyes, Senator Hefner. Senator Keyes, we are voting on the Johnson amendment to the second Venditte amendment.

CLERK: Senator Vickers voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak, for what purpose do you arise? Yes. The motion is to raise the Call. The Call is raised. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. We are ready for the third Venditte amendment. I am sorry. We have to vote on the Venditte amendment as amended. Are you ready for that vote? Are you ready to vote on that? Senator Venditte, do you wish to close? Okay, Senator Venditte waives closing. All those in favor of the second Venditte amendment as amended vote aye, opposed vote no. While you are voting, sometime ago underneath the South balcony there was Mr. Norguard, Millie Heiser, Isabelle Dryden, all from Senator Cullan's District and under the South balcony, I am sorry, in the South balcony, 50 eighth grade students and one teacher, Ft. Calhoun, Nebraska High School in Senator George's District and they will be recorded in the Journal. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Venditte's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment as amended is adopted. Now what about amendment (3)?

CLERK: Read Venditte amendment (3) as found on page 620, Legislative Journal. That is offered by Senator Venditte.
