

I think we can go one by one very quickly. The first one says, "On page 2, line 8, after 'intent' insert 'and result'". That is just in the definition of abortion. We are making sure it does include result. I see Senator Chambers' light comes on. There is a question as to whether the word "or" was left in through a bill drafting error or whatever. I guess that is somewhat unimportant at this point. It makes it clear that the result is a factor in the definition, and because, as I pointed out on the floor previously, we already have in the new criminal code "attempt", "attempt", attempted abortion would be covered thereby without dealing with it specifically in the statute. So I urge adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now the Chair needs to get this clear. Are you proposing all the...okay, the motion is on the first amendment on page 638, lines 2 and 3. Senator Chambers, do you wish to speak to that first amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All I wanted to do was to be sure that he means we are going to take them one at a time and vote one at a time. He says that is it so that is what this question was for.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are no other lights on so I am going to call for a vote on amendment #1 on page 638. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment on page 638, lines 2 and 3. Have you all voted? Okay, the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the DeCamp amendment (1).

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Next we have amendment #2, lines 4 through 13.

SENATOR DeCAMP: We are not going to deal with lines 4 through 13. Where it says on page 5, line 7, strike "situation", that is as far as this goes, because as I say, everything else is covered in the Venditte amendments. On page 5, line 7, strike "situation" is the total amendment. All that does is eliminate the word "situation" because it is a confusing possibly ambiguous word. There is, to the best of my knowledge, not one bit of disagreement on that.

SPEAKER MARVEL: My understanding that the proposal is on page 638 and it is line 4 which states "On page 5, line 7, strike 'situation'" and that is amendment #2. Senator Fowler, do you wish to be recognized on the second amendment?
