SENATOR NICHOL: Thank you. We are voting on advancement of LB 404. Those voting in favor of the advancement please vote aye. Those opposed no.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye.

SENATOR NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: LB 404 is advanced. We will move on to LB 59. Senator Koch, did you wish to speak to the amendments or to the bill first?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 59. Title read. The bill was first read on January 4. It was referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Koch's Education Committee.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments before we get into the intent of the bill, please. I so move.

SENATOR NICHOL: You are voting on the adoption of the amendments. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed no.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye.

SENATOR NICHOL: We are voting on the amendments, please. Have you all voted? Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR NICHOL: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, this bill was brought to me by the Crippled Children's Commission of the State of Nebraska. I am sure that most of you are aware of the fact this commission has been in place since 1967.
