SENATOR DeCAMP: I'm saying that they are prohibited from using any of these kind of practices under this kind of legislation, in fact, they'd go to prison for trying something like that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are you saying those practices have not developed in the loan industry in Nebraska right now, as of this morning while we're talking here?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Senator Chambers, I doubt small loan companies are using those practices.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I believe there are people in loan sharking business using things like that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator DeCamp. It's obvious that Senator DeCamp is either totally naive, or he is not telling the truth here this morning, and after today, we will talk about some of these things, Senator DeCamp, and we'll look at some of these companies and see just how far you're willing to go with legislation to protect the public. Now, he stands up here and tells you how this is such a wonderful bill, and how it's going to help the people, then when even conservatives stand up here and say that Senator Fowler has
