SENATOR KAHLE: Well, the trouble that I have...you mean every day? Every hour? Every month? Every week?

SENATOR MURPHY: According to the bill, Senator, if you will read it, it says monthly.

SENATOR KAHLE: Month?

SENATOR MURPHY: Monthly.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, that's what I'm trying to find out. I don't know whether you realize that anytime you go pay your taxes, or anybody else, that has to be divided into about twenty or thirty different subdivisions of government in the average county. So, monthly, I really do not oppose this, but I just wanted to make sure that you know what you're doing, and that report doesn't mean a thing unless that subdivision of government comes in with an order for that money signed by the officials of that subdivision.

SENATOR MURPHY: Which, I think, Senator, has no bearing on this bill whatsoever. That's a current process that they go through. This bill simply says...

SENATOR KAHLE: That's correct, but I think there are people in this body that feel that just because that report goes out the check is going with it. That is not true.

SENATOR MURPHY: That is not true.

SENATOR KAHLE: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, it appears to me that Orval Keyes is okay, and vote no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy, do you wish to close on the motion to advance the bill?

SENATOR MURPHY: Inasmuch as it is really not my bill, it is a Committee bill, I certainly would move the readvancement of the bill as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 211 to E & R for Engrossment...

SENATOR WESELY: Ask for a machine vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me.
