SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, under those conditions I will request a Call of the House and a record vote, roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Call of the House. Will you clear the board? The question is shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators will please take their seats, indicate their presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Please indicate your presence. The House is under Call in regard to Senator Koch's motion to return 316 to Select File. Senator Hefner, will you record your presence, please? Senator Johnson. Senator Warner, will you record your presence, please? Senator Burrows, Senator Keyes, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz, Senator Goodrich, Senator Wagner, Senator Newell. The House is under Call. Senator Kremer, we are under Call. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, we are missing two legislators. Will you please help us find them? First, Senator Keyes, secondly, Senator Goodrich. Senator Koch, everyone is accounted for except Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KOCH: Senator Keyes is over with the Secretary of State I understand. We can proceed though, Mr. Speaker, but I would like the Clerk to read the amendment since obviously some people were not present, and I am sure they want to defend the right of the woman like I do.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to read the amendment?

CLERK: (Reread Koch amendment as found on page 800 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on pages 800-801 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, we are under Call and you have not recorded your presence, but you must return to your seat. Okay, proceed.

CLERK: (Continued reading roll call vote.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised.
