SENATOR KELLY: Negative, that is incorrect. I would withdraw my motion to return LB 223 to Select File for the specific amendments and I would withdraw my motion to return only. The object would be to enter this motion to return at a later date, probably tomorrow, Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well in other words... Just a moment. The introducer of the amendments has a right to withdraw those amendments. Senator Lewis, do you wish to speak to Senator Kelly's...

SENATOR LEWIS: No, sir. I would like to speak to the bill at hand now. The reason that wasn't on Final Reading today was because Senator Kelly obviously made a motion. That motion could not have been addressed unless the bill was on Final Reading. I think we have played around enough and I don't know what kind of game is going on but, Mr. President, I ask to suspend the rules and read 223 today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill has to lay over one day, Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Speaker, that bill was scheduled for Final Reading just like every other bill was. Today in Senator Kelly's motion, took it out of the final... Is that correct? It was originally scheduled for the 14th. Is that right, Pat? The board shows the 14th. The board shows the 15th. Then we won't do that, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, do you wish to be recognized? Your light is on. Do you wish to be recognized on...? Okay. All right. Senator Kelly has asked to withdraw the motion to return. Is that correct? Read the motion, Mr. Clerk.
