CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. Senator Cullan, do you want to move the adoption of the committee amendments?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, I would like to clarify one thing with Senator Nichol. Senator Nichol, I wonder if you could...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, just a moment. The Chair is recognizing you for the purpose of closing.

SENATOR CULLAN: I intend to. Senator Nichol, you are mistaken about this bill creating another commission. The bill is being amended so that there is no change whatsoever in the administrative structure of the Department of Roads. The bill does not require any additional state employees. The bill does not set up a new board or a new commission. I'm not sure where that came from but that is not done in this bill and that is not a reason to oppose it. I think the bill has been adequately debated and I would move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments to LB 42. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 42. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the committee amendments are adopted. Do you have another amendment on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely moves to amend. (Read Wesely's amendment found on page 954 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, just a moment. May we have your attention? These are rather voluminous amendments and we need to... Will you reread the Wesely amendment to LB 42?

CLERK: Reread Wesely amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.
