PRESIDENT: No objection. So ordered. We're ready then for Final Reading. The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, how many people are excused this morning?

PRESIDENT: Six.

SENATOR DWORAK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: Are we ready for Final Reading? No, we're not, because members are not at their desks. As soon as all the members are at their desks, we'll commence with LB 316. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 316.

CLERK: (Read LB 316.)

PRESIDENT: Request for roll call vote. All provisions of law relative to the procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 316 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on Pages 968 and 969 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 4 nays, and 6 excused and not voting, Mr. resident.

PRESIDENT: LB 316 passes on Final Reading.
