SENATOR NICHOL: It removes the lists that are exempt now.

SENATOR NEWELL: But does it...does it...is it still confined to voter registration lists, or does it add social security...people who might not have...not be registered to vote, but might have a driver's license, or does it allow for others other than just the limitations on the
