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a great deal of money. I know, I can speak for, and I would say this. I would say there are probably more bingos, bingo halls and bingo games being played in Senator Labeledz and my district than any other place in the State of Nebraska. I am sure that these ladies who are hearing us talk on this issue this morning, we may not get their vote next year. It is a very sensitive issue to these people. They would play bingo four or five times a day seven days a week even on Christmas Day, Easter. Well, ladies and gentlemen, I think we have to put, you know, we have got to start playing with a full deck here and be honest with ourselves. We know that if we limit these number of bingos to two nights a week, I can assure you, ladies and gentlemen, that the money will remain where it should be and that is where the Legislature originally wanted the money to be and that is in the hands of the nonprofit charitable organizations in this state. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, do you wish to speak to the Johnson amendment?

SENATOR DeCAMP: I call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the question. Are there five seconds? The Chair sees five seconds. The question before the House is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Simon, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, I would like to have the question divided please. There are two issues. I would like to be able to vote on each one separately, support one and not the other.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If I understand your request, we are going to vote first on the Johnson amendment to the committee amendment.

SENATOR SIMON: No, sir. Senator Johnson has two portions. One deals with the number of times bingo can be played. The second one deals with custodians. I would like to have the amendment to the amendment divided.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Johnson is amending two sections and these are referred to as section 1 and section 2. Is this what you are referring to?
