SENATOR SIMON: The first issue is going to be the number of times a week and the second one is going to be the custodians.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, The Clerk will read the first part of the Johnson amendment to the committee amendments.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Johnson moves to strike section 1 of the committee amendments. Do you want me to read those committee amendments again?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, why don't you read it again so everybody knows what they are voting on?

CLERK: Senator Johnson moves to strike section 1 of the committee amendments which read as follows: On page 3, line 2 after "services" insert "and custodial services". In line 5, strike "ten" and show as stricken, insert "fourteen". In line 15 strike "two" and insert "three" and in line 25 strike "two" and insert "three".

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting first of all upon the first portion of the Johnson amendment to the committee amendments and the Clerk has read it. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 3 nays on the adoption of Senator Johnson's first amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first Johnson amendment is adopted. Now the Clerk will read the second amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the second Johnson amendment reads to strike section 2 of the committee amendments which read as follows: On page 5, line 9, after "equipment" insert "custodial services".

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair has two lights on. Senator Newell, do you wish to be recognized? Debate has ceased. I am sorry. We are voting on the second amendment. Did you read the amendment?

CLERK: Yes, I did.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is on the second Johnson amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor of the second Johnson amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 2 nays.
