LB 267, 273

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 267. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of LB 267 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Okay I am going to call once more and then I am going to call for the vote. Have you all voted? Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I would like to have a Call of the House, please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are eleven excused. The question is, shall the house go under Call. Eleven. All those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed vote no. Shall the house go under Call? Record.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 11 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 16 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, we are ready for... we have two bills, 273 and 414. The Clerk will read 273 first.

SENATOR KEYES: 273 first.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 273.) The bill was first read on January 15. It was referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Keyes' committee.

SENATOR KEYES: I move we adopt the committee amendments. Now the committee amendments just describe what a paraplegic is and give him permission to get a tax exemption on his home and on his mobile home and on the car that he drives and we further described it down there. In the mobile home owned or occupied by a disabled or a blind person... that is the only two things that the amendments do and I move for the adoption of the amendments.
