I repeat, the committee amendments correct technical errors that came out of the bill drafter's office, some internal references.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you move the adoption of the committee amendments? The motion first is on the adoption of the committee amendments to 180. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.
