SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Clark, then Senator Kremer, then Senator Marsh and then we will try for a vote on the first part. Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, members, I am going to have to agree with Senator Cullan. Really I don't know why these amendments weren't probably brought to our committee ahead of time rather than to do it now. We are completely changing this bill under the color of an amendment. Certainly if you would put them on you would want another public hearing. It would be hard for me to think that you couldn't bring a bill in next year and address the question forthrightly with all these particular amendments on a bill, have a public hearing, find out what the people really think about this. I don't care whether they are consumers, or undertakers or who they are. I will agree with Senator Lamb that certainly you are not in any position to bargain effectively. I have gone through that three times in the last six years. You are not in any position to bargain. You can't even bargain with two different funeral directors because you have a body of one but I know that if we put all these amendments on here that what we are going to have to do is send it back to committee for hearing. It is going to take a lot longer to do it and there is no reason why you couldn't put a sunset bill in next year the same way and put all the amendments on it that you want on it at that time, put it right directly in the bill and have a public hearing on it. So I am going to have to agree with Senator Cullan that certainly we ought to have this bill go through this year so we don't lose the control that we do have on funeral directors at the present time. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, members, Senator Chambers, may I ask you a question please?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: The question, Senator Chambers, and this is not your fault, this is mine, I have not had the time to review these amendments and they are extensive and it is not your fault, it is mine, I would like to ask you this question. Were these extensive amendments proposed or reviewed at the committee hearing level?
